# Administration and MatchSecretary's notes

Another successful year for the Association has now passed and I wish you all Best Wishes for the New Year and a successful 2014 under the leadership of our new Captain John Pettitt. Ken was very lucky last year with the weather and I hope it is just as kind to John.

Membership is still a key issue for the Association even though we managed to recruit as many members as we lost last year. However a membership of around 150 is low compared to most other counties and makes it difficult to find a team sometimes, particularly towards the end of the year. Experience has shown that the best way to get new members is for you to introduce your captain and ex captains to the Association. Ken and John and a couple of others, did this very well last year, and I ask that all of you try to recruit for us this year. Club membership is still in decline, but most clubs appoint a Captain, and we need to attract them to join.

To take some of the burden off me we are going to appoint match managers for some of the matches this year. Most other counties do this already and it seems to work OK. We will decide which ones to start with and I will let you know the procedure then. The Committee members are going to do 2 or 3 and I have 1 volunteer also. If anyone else wishes to do so please let me know.

Looking at the season ahead, you will also get with this Newsletter the Annual Booklet, the usual fixture details with the request that you indicate your interest in the respective fixtures by marking the adjacent boxes and where able, give some indication that you might be available at short notice, as this is so important when I have to deal with late withdrawals. We will ensure that everyone gets a game. The returns will be used as the



basis of team selection in late February and if you wish John to consider you please ensure you respond by the end of January. It is suggested that you enter your requests in your personal diary to avoid the chance of double bookings and the need to consider cancelling if selected later in the year.

You are also asked to pay your renewal fee for the season and there is a standing order form available on the website for this to make it a little bit easier for the Treasurer.

Finally please contact me if you have any concerns, issues or requests and I will do what I can to ensure the continuing smooth running, tradition and success of the Association.
